

Camera-Ready Make-up Tips

Foundation, concealer and powder should be used to make skin look smooth and blemish free. A conservative amount of blush should be used to highlight cheekbones.

Eyeshadow should be used to contour eyes. Medium toned colors should be used. Avoid extremely light, dark, pigmented, or shimmery colors.

Lips should be lined and colored with a neutral lipcolor. Again, avoid the extremes of light, dark, and shimmer.

Avoid anything that screams "trendy." It should not look like a Glamour shot, but who you are before you become a character.
